The Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM or the Department) has reviewed Fort McClellan's *Final Five-Year Review Report*. The review concluded that the response actions continue to minimize explosives safety risks and continue to be protective of human health, safety, and environment. There was no evidence of erosion, no evidence of MEC (munitions and explosives of concern), and no change in land use since the last review at any of the sites except for road construction on Summerall Road in the Eastern Bypass OES1 and construction on the M1.01 and the M2 parcels found during the visual inspection of the sites. All sites will continue to be monitored, with the next five-year review being conducted in 2011. ADEM concurs with the document.
