




Notification
Of Intent

The United States Army intends to sign a Finding of Suitability to Transfer (FOST) for the transfer of approximately 22.94 acres of land consisting of five water tank site areas: MOUT Road Water Tank Site, Fort Water Tank Site, Bains Gap Water Tank Site, Snap Road Water Tank Site, and Rucker Avenue Water Tanks Site. * All the water tank site areas with the exception of the Fort Water Tank Site are located on former ranges that were used for military training. The Fort Water Tank Site and the Rucker Avenue Water Tank Site contain reservoirs (previously transferred) that were used for storage of potable water. The FOST describes the environmental condition of the property that is being prepared for transfer to the Anniston-Calhoun County Fort McClellan Development Joint Powers Authority. Copies of the FOST are available for public review at the Anniston Calhoun County Library on the 1st Floor, 108 E. 10th Street, Anniston, AL 36201, and the Houston Cole Library on the 9th Floor, Jacksonville State University, 700 Pelham Rd, Jacksonville, AL 36265.
