The Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM or the Department) has reviewed Fort McClellan's *Final Work Plan Remedial Action in Charlie Area for Four Lead Removal Sites*. The Army has consolidated the requirements for conducting an explosives inventory to one location in the document. The work plan now allows authorized visitors in the exclusion zone. Also, the quality control (QC) process program is explained in more detail including further explanation of the QC seeding program and the development of a table listing all of the required QC inspections.
