The United States Army intends to sign an Action Memorandum to document the selected munitions response action to address munitions and explosives of concern (MEC) on a 10.07 acre parcel of property located on Fort McClellan, Alabama, known as the Iron Mountain Road Addition. An Engineering Evaluation and Cost Analysis (EE/CA) has been prepared for the property. The EE/CA presents an evaluation of alternatives for a munitions response action and a recommended munitions response action for implementation at the site.
