The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers completed a five-year review for the GSA Warehouse Area at Fort McClellan, Alabama, a Base Realignment and Closure site. Because of the presence of low levels of organic chemicals in groundwater, and elevated lead levels in soil caused by lead-based paint, the U.S. Army placed land use controls in the form of deed restrictions on the property. The purpose of the five-year review is to determine if the land use controls continue to be protective of human health and the environment. Copies of the five-year review report are available to the public for review at www.mcclellan.army.mil, and are also on file at the Anniston Calhoun County Library on the 1st Floor, 108 E. 10th Street, Anniston, AL 36201, and the Houston Cole Library on the 9th Floor, Jacksonville State University, 700 Pelham Rd, Jacksonville, AL 36265.
